Price per person includes: 7 nights accommodation in moderate/first class hotels and comfortable lodges, 1 dinner, 4 picnic lunches or breakfasts (depending on weather), Jasper tour, Banff tour, hotel pick up and drop off in Vancouver, transportation by air-conditioned minivan, VIA Rail train (access to lounge, observation domes, restaurant), park fees, GST. Maximum 9 passengers.

Discover the pristine lakes, glaciers and towering mountains of the Rockies by minivan, as well as a spectacular section by train aboard VIA Rail's 'The Canadian'. Visit Banff and the Icefields Parkway, beautiful Lake Louise, Glacier National Park, Revelstoke and the historic Okanagan Valley.

Day 1 Kamloops
 Depart Vancouver along the scenic Sea to Sky Highway and into the Coast Mountain Range. Stop at Whistler before continuing onto Kamloops for overnight.

Day 2 Jasper
 Board Via Rail's 'The Canadian' for a journey through the spectacular Rockies to Jasper with access to the rear car lounge and observation domes. Spend the remainder of the day exploring the many sites of Jasper. Overnight at Fairmont Jasper Park Lodge or similar.

Day 3 Banff
 We drive the spectacular Icefields Parkway and may see local wildlife and view the Athabasca and Dome Glaciers as well as Peyto and Bow Lakes. After a tour of Banff overnight at the High Country Inn or similar.

Day 4 Banff
 Visit beautiful Lake Louise and Moraine Lake. Return to Banff for free time or choose an optional tour of Banff including the Banff Springs Hotel, the Cave and Basin and Sulphur Mountain. Overnight High Country Inn or similar.

Day 5 Revelstoke
 Explore the magnificent Glacier National Park with its deep, rugged valleys and Spiral Railway Tunnels. Continue over historic Rogers Pass and the Columbia Mountains to Revelstoke for overnight.

Day 6 Okanagan
 Drive high above the sub alpine tree line to Mt Revelstoke for stunning views and possible catch some early morning wildlife. Afterwards leave the Rockies for The Okanagan, the 'fruit basket of B.C.'. Overnight in South Kelowna.

Day 7 Penticton
 Explore the highlights of The Okanagan, including wineries, and to view the historic trestles of the old Kettle Valley Railroad. Overnight in the Penticton area.

Day 8 Tour ends Vancouver
 Head out of the valley back to Vancouver, viewing the Fraser River and the farming areas of the Fraser Delta en route. Tour ends in Vancouver.
