Day 1 VIA Rail

Make your own way to Vancouver's Pacific Central Station for your journey through the Rockies. Board "The Canadian" at 19.30 and travel through Fraser Canyon and Hell's Gate. Dinner and overnight on board.

Day 2 Jasper

Travel through the Monashee and Cariboo Mountains to Jasper. Overnight at a hotel. BL

Day 3 Jasper

Tour by coach through outstanding scenery via Medicine Lake and Maligne Canyon. Cruise on beautiful Maligne Lake. Overnight Jasper.

Day 4 Banff

Drive the Icefields Parkway through Jasper and Banff National Parks. At Columbia Icefield, tour the Athabasca Glacier by the Brewster Ice Explorer. Brief stop at Lake Louise before continuing onto Banff for overnight.

Day 5 Lake Louise

Tour of Banff and environs, ascend Tunnel Mountain, visit the Cave and Basin National Historic Site and stroll along Lake Minnewanka. Afternoon transfer to Lake Louise for overnight.

Day 6 Lac Le Jeune

Travel via Kicking Horse Canyon and stop at Revelstoke for lunch (included). Continue past the Shuswap Lakes to the Lac Le Jeune Resort for overnight. Dinner included. LD

Day 7 Vancouver

Follow the turbulent Fraser River before lunch at Lillooet on the old Caribou Wagon Road. Enjoy a short stop at Whistler before returning to Vancouver for overnight. BL

Day 8 Tour ends

Tour ends today in Vancouver.

Day 8 Prince George

Day 9 Jasper

Reboard the train and follow the Fraser River, which cuts through moose and bear country, to the alpine town of Jasper. BL

Days 10/11 Banff
