Explore all the highlights of the Rockies off the beaten track. Hike through alpine meadows, take an overnight canoe trip, camp beneath snow-capped peaks and soak in hot springs. This adventurous camping trip requires a moderate level of activity with hikes of 1 to 4 hours in length. You will need to pitch your own tent, help with meals and other chores. Optional activities (additional cost) include horseback riding, rafting, guided ice walk, mountain bike and kayak rentals.

Day 1 Nahatlatch National Park

Depart Vancouver at 08.00am, driving through the scenic Fraser Canyon to the old-growth wilderness of Nahatlatch National Park, home to abundant wildlife. Overnight camping.

Day 2 Wells Gray Park

Hike to beautiful Mehatl Falls before departing north following Thompson River to Caribou Country, a region of rolling hills, prairies, forests and canyons. Overnight Wells Gray Buffalo Ranch.

Day 3 Wells Gray Park

Explore the magnificent wilderness of Wells Gray Park. View Helmcken Falls, and take an overnight canoe trip on beautiful Lake Clearwater. Overnight camping.

Days 4/5 Jasper National Park

After a morning exploring the Lake Clearwater shoreline, drive north to Mt Robson Provincial Park. On day 5 visit Maligne Lake and hike Maligne Canyon, an area rich with wildlife including bears, elk and moose. Enjoy an evening excursion on the Jasper Tramway to the top of Whistler Mountain. Overnight camping.

Days 6/7 Banff NP & Lake Louise

Full day sightseeing along the Icefield's Parkway and visit to Athabasca Glacier with the option of a guided walk with crampons. On Day 7 hike Johnston Canyon, visit Lake Louise and Moraine Lake. Free time in Banff for optional activities. Overnight camping.

Days 8/9 Yoho National Park

Visit the wonders of Yoho NP and enjoy a range of optional activities including whitewater rafting, horseback riding or visiting the Kicking Horse Grizzly Bear Refuge. On day 9 hike to Emerald Lake and visit Takakawa Falls. Overnight camping.

Day 10 Shuswap Lake

Drive through mountain passes including Roger's Pass at Glacier NP where you will enjoy local nature trails. Continue through the Monashee Mountains before staying overnight at the Quaaout Lodge on the shores of Little Shuswap Lake.

Day 11 Tour ends Vancouver

Drive along the Trans Canada Highway and over the scenic Coquihalla Highway to Hope and then on to Vancouver. Tour ends.
