Explore all the highlights of the Rockies off the beaten track. Hike through alpine meadows, camp beneath snow-capped peaks and soak in hot springs. This adventurous camping trip requires a moderate level of fitness and you will need to pitch your own tent, help with meals and other chores.

Day 1 Nahatlatch National Park

Early departure, driving through the scenic Fraser Canyon to the old-growth wilderness of Nahatlatch National Park. Overnight camping.

Days 2-4 Wells Gray Park

Experience the wilderness of Wells Gray Park, with hikes to view wildlife and stunning scenery including Caribou and Monashee Mountains, and the Helmcken Falls. Overnight bunkhouse & camping.

Days 5/6 Jasper National Park

Explore the largest of the Rocky Mountains National Parks, with a visit to Maligne Lake and Canyon. In the evening take the aerial tram to the top of Whistler Mountain. Overnight camping.

Days 7/8 Banff National Park

Travel along the famous Icefield's Parkway to Banff. Highlights along the way include Athabasca Falls and views of the glaciers. On day 8 soak in the Sulphur Mountain Hot Springs. Overnight camping.

Days 9/10 Yoho & Glacier National Parks

Visit Lake Louise, Kicking Horse Pass, the Spiral Tunnel viewpoint, Takakkaw Falls and the Emerald Green Lake. Explore Glacier National Park. Overnight in guest houses and lodge.

Day 11 Tour ends Vancouver

Drive to Vancouver. Tour ends.

Price per person includes: Return floatplane transfers ex Whitehorse, full board cabin accommodation with bedding, solar power and fire wood. Main Lodge with shower, sauna & hot tub, use of mountain bikes and/or canoe/kayak including lifejackets, 1 guided nature interpretive walk (approx 1 hour), 1 full day boating /sightseeing tour with optional canoeing OR fishing (approx 6 hours). 5D/4N package also includes 1 half day guided hike OR guided canoe/kayak trip (approx 4 hours).

Price excludes: alcoholic beverages, fishing license.

Accessible only by boat or floatplane this intimate eco lodge is situated on Tagish Lake amongst pristine wilderness. Just four cosy guest cabins surround the main lodge, for a true wilderness experience. Explore the area by boat, kayak and on foot with excellent guides in search of wildlife such as bears, moose, caribou, beaver and lynx. Your friendly hosts will make you welcome with hearty home-cooked meals. Unwind in the hot tub or sauna after the day's adventures.

Day 1 Tagish Wilderness Lodge

Floatplane flight from Whitehorse to Tagish Lake and your wilderness lodge. Rest of the day at leisure to explore on foot, by bike or by canoe on the lake. Dinner and overnight at the lodge.

Days 2/3 Tagish Wilderness Lodge

Over the next two days you will take guided excursions by boat and canoe looking out for busy beavers on the waterways or moose in the woods. Take nature walks or longer hikes according to your wishes and level of ability. Enjoy daily fresh baked bread, picnic lunches, afternoon snacks and hearty dinners.

Day 4 Tour ends Whitehorse

After breakfast return transfer by floatplane to Whitehorse.
