Journey far from the crowds and get close to whales, bears and sea lions; kayak around icebergs and hike through verdant forests. With limited guests on board (40 Wilderness Adventurer, 52 Wilderness Discoverer, 76 Wilderness Explorer) you will be pampered with a three-to-one guest/crew ratio, healthy meals, well-appointed cabins, spacious common areas and top quality adventure equipment. Naturalist and outdoor guides will lead you on a range of activities, including whale watching, kayaking, paddle boarding, wilderness hiking, fishing, caving, snorkelling and glacier viewing to name a few. Onboard you can relax in the sauna, take a yoga class or take in the incredible scenery from the observation deck.

Cruise through remote and pristine wilderness to Glacier Bay, a UNESCO Heritage Site and one of the "Crown Jewels" of America's national parks. Get close to amazing tidewater glaciers, hike through wildlife-rich forests, and ride skiffs or kayaks along dramatic fjords as you look out for whales. Onboard naturalists accompany all activities.

Day 1 Depart Juneau

Embark your ship, meet the crew and begin cruising the waterways of Alaska's famous Inside Passage. D

Days 2-4 Glacier Bay National Park

Your adventure begins as you enter Glacier Bay National Park. For the next 3 days a park ranger will join the cruise to guide you to special coves and inlets most visitors don't see. Explore the magnificent scenery and look out for sea lions, mountain goats, bears, moose and eagles. Enjoy a visit to South Marble Island to spot many species of birds before reaching Glacier Bay with its massive rivers of ice sweeping down to the water. At night the bay is yours with the boat anchoring in a secluded cove. Conditions permitting you may also get the chance to hike or kayak within in the park. BLD

Day 5 Icy Strait

Join the expedition leader and naturalists on deck as the boat heads for Icy Strait, one of the richest areas for whales and other marine animals. Board the skiffs and explore the coastline where bears and other animals are often seen. Relax in the hot tub before dinner. BLD

Day 6 Chichagof Island

Your expert crew will navigate the dramatic shoreline of Chichagof Island with its many waterfalls. In the evening you may anchor in Red Bluff Bay or another sheltered cove where, weather permitting, skiffs or kayaks may be lowered so you can explore. BLD

Day 7 Peril Strait

Cruise through wildlife-rich Peril Strait and the Sergius Narrows which can only be navigated by small ship. Explore the shoreline for bears, otters, whales and look out for eagles. Farewell Dinner on board and presentation of a "photo journal" of your holiday. BLD

Day 8 Disembark Sitka

After breakfast cruise into Sitka and disembark. Transfer to the airport. Tour ends. B

Day 1 Depart Juneau

Board the ship and meet the crew before enjoying dinner onboard. D

Day 2 Windham Bay/Frederick Sound

Spend the morning hiking and kayaking around Windham Bay. Reboard and cruise to Frederick Sound, the summer feeding ground of large concentrations of Humpback Whales. BLD

Day 3 Thomas Bay/ Baird Glacier

Today choose to hike the Baird Glacier Trail, take a long kayak from Scenery Cove to Cascade Creek or spend a leisurely day onboard. BLD

Day 4 LeConte Bay

Cruise through the ice rich waters of LeConte Bay, home to a tidewater glacier. Relax with a yoga class or kayak through the chilly waters viewing the amazing natural beauty of the glacier. At night look out for the lights of "Christmas Tree Lane" as the boat heads to Wrangell. BLD

Day 5 Wrangell

Rise early to fish for King Salmon (optional, additional cost) before experiencing some local Tlingit culture at Chief Shakes Tribal House and Kiksetti Totem Park. In the afternoon you may choose to kayak the scenic channels along the eastern shore of Etolin Island. BLD

Day 6 Yes Bay

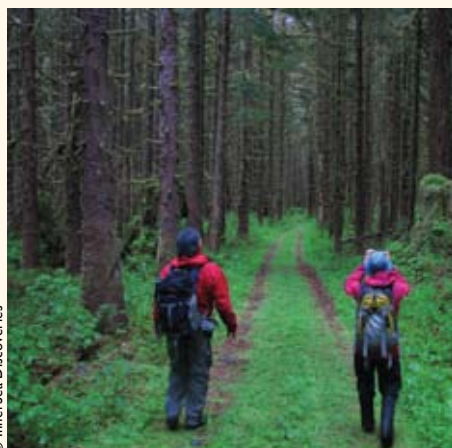
Travel to Yes Bay and the wildlife rich Tongass National Forest. Explore with a kayak or nature hike with the chance to see whales, Orca, porpoise, seals, bears, eagles and otters. BLD

Day 7 Misty Fjords N'tl Monument

Watch the sun rise over the sheer walls of the Misty Fjords National Monument Wilderness Area. Glide along by kayak to Walker Cove and stop at the shoreline beaches. BLD

Day 8 Tour ends Ketchikan

After breakfast disembark for a transfer to Ketchikan airport. Tour ends. B

SAMPLE ITINERARY

Day 1 Depart Ketchikan

Board the ship, meet the crew and enjoy a delicious dinner while cruising through Clarence Strait. D

Day 2 El Capitan Passage

Explore El Capitan Passage, the 27 mile long waterway that divides Prince of Wales and Kosciusko Islands. Paddle around Devilfish Cove or to El Capitan Cave before an afternoon visit to Marble Island to pick up some freshly caught seafood for dinner. BLD

Day 3 Klawock

Visit the Tlingit village of Klawock to learn about native Alaska and view colourful totem poles. Explore the surrounds on foot or by kayak, looking out for bears, eagles and whales. BLD

Day 4 Port Walter/Baranof Island

This morning choose from a half day fishing excursion (additional cost), a hike through the Baranof Island wilderness, or kayak between Little Port Walter and Big Port Walter. BLD

Day 5 Patterson Bay

Spend the day leisurely exploring the bay by skiff or kayak, take a guided hike or snorkel. BLD

Day 6 The Brothers/Frederick Sound

Visit The Brothers islands in Frederick Sound, abundant with wildlife including Stellar sea lions. Choose from a guided kayak trip or skiff tour to watch the sea lions as they parade on the shore. Reboard and cruise to the summer feeding ground of large concentrations of Humpback Whales. BLD

Day 7 Dawes Glacier/Ford's Terror

Experience the wonder of Dawes Glacier by kayak or skiff. Tide permitting, travel along the narrow passage of Ford's Terror and admire the domes, hanging valleys and wilderness that surround it before reboarding for a farewell dinner. BLD

Day 8 Tour ends Juneau

After breakfast disembark for a transfer to Juneau airport. Tour ends. B

Cruise for 900 nautical miles between Seattle and Juneau via the famed Inside Passage. Travel through a breathtaking wilderness of snow-capped mountains, exceptional wildlife and wilderness, narrow tree-lined passageways and charming port towns. Early May or September are the best time for cruising with vivid foliage, fewer boats and active bears and other animals foraging along the shoreline.

SAMPLE ITINERARY

Day 1 Depart Seattle

Transfer from the airport and board the ship to cruise northward via Puget Sound, continuing on through the narrow Deception Pass. D

Days 2/3 Washington's San Juan Islands

Arrive at Friday Harbour in the misty forests of the San Juan Islands. Explore the town and on day 3 enjoy "gunkholing" around the different islands by skiff, kayak or on foot. As you depart the islands keep a lookout for Orca Whales. BLD

Days 4-7 Canada's Inside Passage

Head northward watching out for Orca Whales, seals, sea lions, dolphins, porpoise and migratory birds. Visit remote communities including Alert Bay, home to the world's largest totem pole, Butedale a former cannery town and Misty Fjords National monument with its sheer rock walls. BLD

Day 8 Ketchikan, Alaska

Learn about the culture of the local Tlingit Indian with a visit to Saxman Totem Village and the shops along Creek Street. BLD

Day 9 El Capitan Passage/ Devilfish Bay

El Capitan Passage, the waterway that divides Prince of Wales and Kosciusko Islands is a great place to get close to nature. Hike along an old logging trail and paddle around Devilfish Cove before moving on to Marble Island for some freshly caught seafood. BLD

Day 10 Klawock

Visit the Tlingit village of Klawock to learn about the history of native Alaska and the cultural importance of carving. See the 21 colourfully restored totem poles that dot the town, or take an afternoon kayak trip. BLD

Day 11 Port Walter/Baranof Island

This morning choose from a half day fishing excursion (additional cost), a hike through the wilderness of Baranof Island or a shorter walk to an abandoned cannery. In the afternoon hike in Mist Cove taking in the amazing views, including an enormous waterfall. BLD

Day 12 Patterson Bay

Wake up in Patterson Bay and spend a restful day discovering the cove by skiff, kayak, or on a guided hike in Tongass National Forest. BLD

Day 13 The Brothers/Frederick Sound

Take a guided kayak trip or skiff tour to watch the sea lions as they noisily parade on the shores of The Brothers islands. Later sail into Frederick Sound, the summer feeding ground of large numbers of Humpback Whales. BLD

Day 14 Dawes Glacier/Ford's Terror

Today experience the glowing blue of Dawes Glacier by kayak or skiff. Tide permitting travel along the narrow passage of Ford's Terror before reboarding for a farewell dinner. BLD

Day 15 Tour ends Juneau

After breakfast disembark for a transfer to Juneau airport. Tour ends. B
