Visit the legendary city of Petra, built by the Nabataeans in 100 BC. Famed for its magnificent rock cut architecture, including the famous Treasury and the Monastery, Petra is now a World Heritage Site.

**Day 1 Petra**

Depart Amman by road travelling via the ancient and scenic Kings Highway to Petra. En route visit the Byzantine mosaics and churches at Madaba, the memorial to Moses on Mt Nebo with magnificent views of the Holy Land, and the crusader stronghold of Kerak. Overnight at your Petra hotel.

**Day 2 Petra**

Full day tour of the Hidden Treasury ancient city of Petra approached via the 1.4 km narrow rock canyon, or Siq. Overnight at your hotel. B

**Day 3 Tour ends Amman**

Morning at leisure before returning via the Desert Highway to Amman. Tour ends. B

**J**ourney through the ancient kingdom of Jordan to the magnificent Greco-Roman ruins at Jerash, the mosaics of Madaba and the fortified Kerak Castle. Walk through the narrow Siq to discover the ancient rock-hewn city of Petra, and float on the buoyant waters of the Dead Sea.

#### Day 1 Amman

You will be met at Amman airport, assisted through visa procedures and transferred to your hotel for 2 nights. With a history thousands of years old, Amman is a mix of ancient and modern, with world class hotels and good restaurants alongside grand mosques, Roman theatres and the Umayyad Royal Palace.

#### Day 2 Amman

Morning guided city tour, including the Roman Theatre and Nymphaeum and the ancient Citadel. Then drive to the astonishingly well-preserved Greco-Roman city of Jerash and walk its colonnaded streets and plazas, discover its temples, theatres, baths and fountains, the hilltop Temple of Artemis and the Triumphal Arch of Hadrian. B

#### Day 3 Petra

Depart down the King's Highway towards Petra, visiting the Byzantine mosaics at Madaba (with a 6th century map of Palestine). Visit Mt Nebo, thought to be the last resting place of Moses, with breathtaking views, and continue to the crusader castle of Kerak. Arrive at your Petra hotel for a 3 night stay. B

#### Day 4 Petra

Full-day private guided tour of Petra approached via the 1.4 km walk down the Siq, or narrow rock canyon. Visit the famous Treasury and other sites in this ancient city. B

#### Day 5 Petra

Day at leisure to continue exploring Petra. B

#### Day 6 Wadi Rum/Dead Sea

Drive to the breathtaking desert landscapes of Wadi Rum, home of Bedouin tribes and made famous by British officer and writer T.E. Lawrence (of Arabia). Take a 4WD desert safari beneath towering sandstone mountains and sculptural rock formations. Continue on to the Dead Sea for two nights.

#### Day 7 Dead Sea

Today is at leisure to swim in the Dead Sea, indulge in one of the many spa packages or just explore the shores of this unique salt lake 422m below sea level. B

#### Day 8 Tour ends Amman

Drive back to Amman where the tour ends. B
