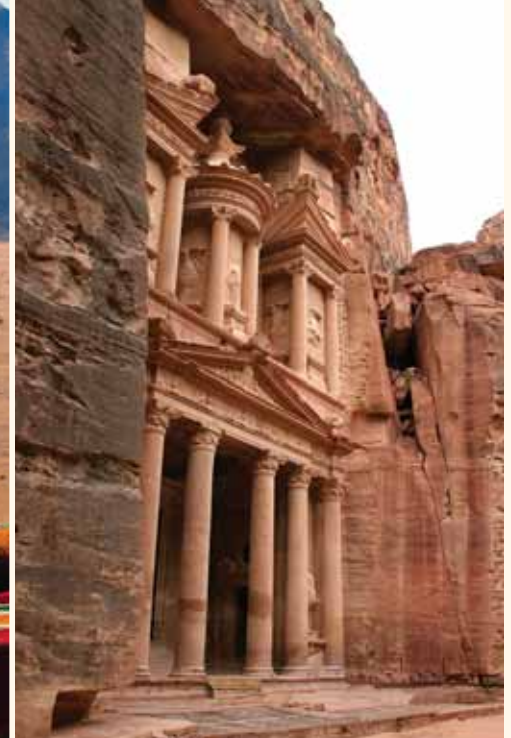

JORDAN

At the cross-roads of east and west Jordan is a treasure trove of historic and religious sites, with ancient temples, mosques and churches, mysterious ruined cities and romantic desert castles. Luckily the country is small enough for visitors to reach many of the major sites with ease, including the capital Amman, the ruins of Jerash, the Dead Sea, the rose-red city of Petra and the stunning desert landscapes of Wadi Rum.

Price per person includes: Amman meet and assist, airport/hotel return transfers in private a/c vehicle, entrance fees, services of local English speaking guide in Jerash and Petra, 2 hr 4WD jeep tour, portages at hotels and airport, horse riding in Petra, entrance to Siq, 6 nights accommodation in hotels on a B&B basis.

Journey through the ancient kingdom of Jordan to the magnificent Greco-Roman ruins at Jerash, the mosaics of Madaba and the fortified Kerak Castle. Walk through the narrow Siq to discover the ancient rock-hewn city of Petra, and float on the buoyant waters of the Dead Sea.

Day 1 Amman

Arrive Amman airport where you are met and transferred to your hotel for 2 nights. Amman is a mix of ancient and modern, with world class hotels and good restaurants alongside grand mosques, Roman theatres and the Umayyad Royal Palace.

Day 2 Amman

Morning city tour, including the Roman Theatre and Nymphaeum and the ancient Citadel. Then drive to the well preserved Greco-Roman city of Jerash and walk its colonnaded streets and plazas, discover its temples, theatres, baths and the Triumphal Arch of Hadrian. B

Day 3 Petra

Depart down the King's Highway towards Petra, visiting the Byzantine mosaics at Madaba (with a 6th century map of Palestine). Visit Mt Nebo, thought to be the last resting place of Moses, with breathtaking views, and continue to the crusader castle of Kerak. Arrive at your Petra hotel for a 2 night stay. B

Day 4 Petra

Full-day private guided tour of Petra approached via a 1.4 km walk down the Siq, or narrow rock canyon. Visit the famous Treasury and other sites in this ancient city. B

Day 6 Wadi Rum/Dead Sea

Drive to the breathtaking desert landscapes of Wadi Rum. Home to Bedouin tribes, it was made famous by British officer and writer T.E. Lawrence (of Arabia). Take a 4WD desert safari beneath towering sandstone mountains and sculptural rock formations. Continue on to the Dead Sea for two nights. B

Day 6 Dead Sea

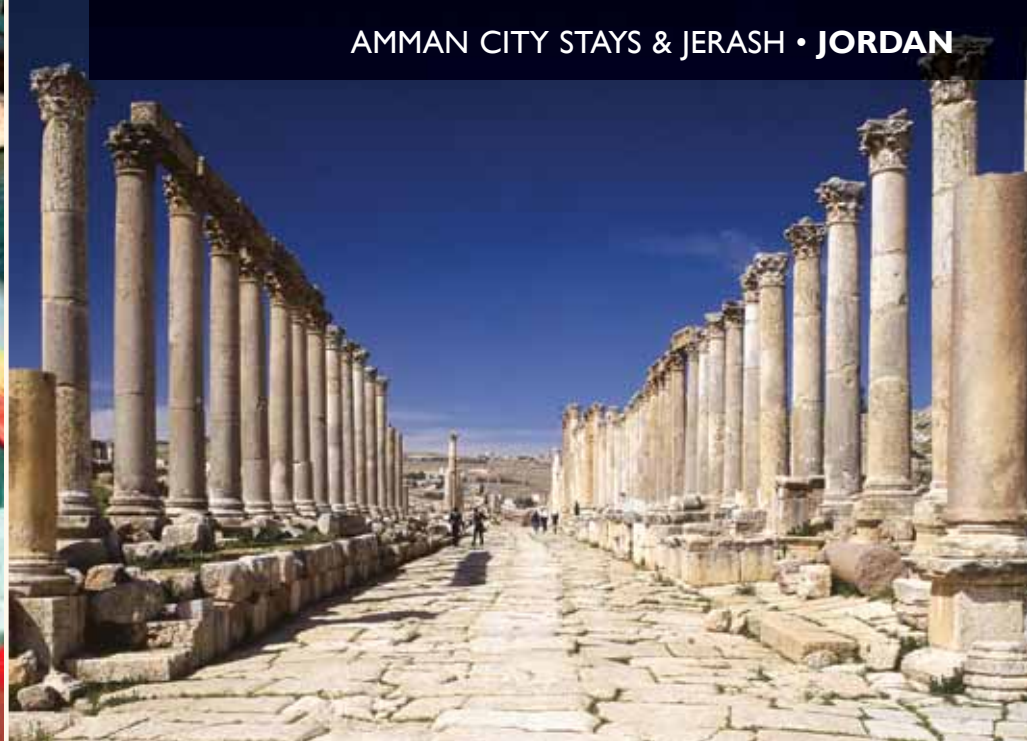
Today is at leisure to swim in the Dead Sea, indulge in one of the many spa treatments or just explore the shores of this unique salt lake 422m below sea level. B

Day 7 Tour ends Amman

Drive back to Amman where the tour ends. B

City Tour

Explore Amman, the capital of Jordan. This tour includes the mesmerizing Roman Theatre, the enchanting Citadel, inhabited since the Bronze Age (3500BC), the Archaeological museum (home of the Dead Sea Scrolls) and King Abdullah Mosque with its stunning blue mosaic dome.

Jerash and Ajlun

Drive north to the Roman city of Jerash where the morning is spent exploring the well-preserved ruins. Jerash is one of the largest archaeological sites of Roman architecture outside Italy. Visit Hadrian's Arch, the huge Roman amphitheatre, temples dedicated to Artemis and Zeus and the ancient Hippodrome. Afterwards continue on to Ajlun Castle, an Islamic fortress built to defend against Crusader attacks in the 12th Century.

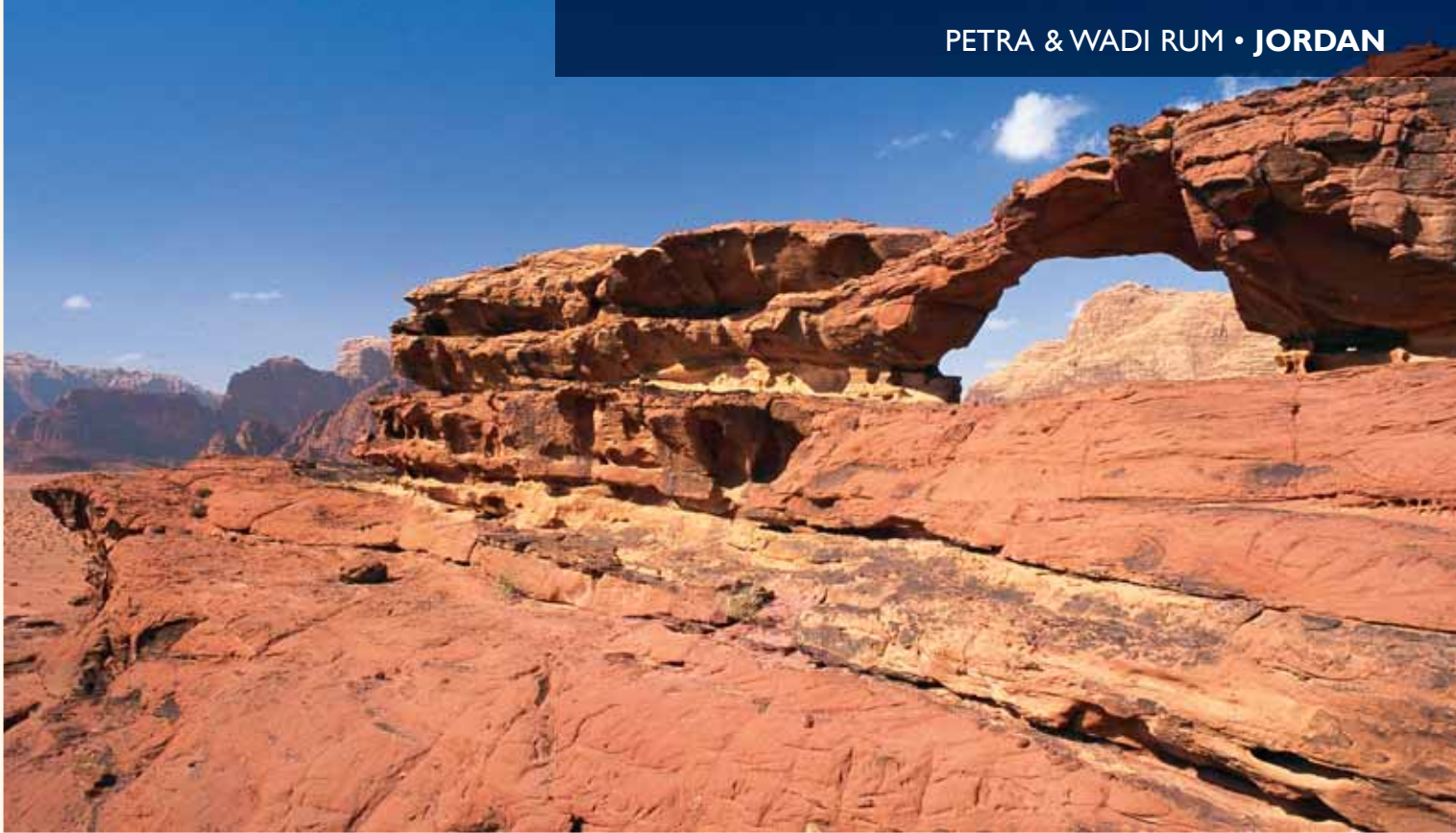

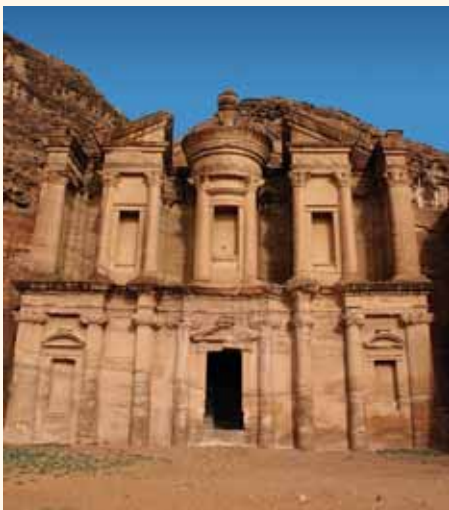

Day 1 Petra

Depart Amman by road travelling via the ancient and scenic Kings Highway to Petra. Enroute visit the Byzantine mosaics and churches at Madaba, the memorial to Moses on Mt Nebo with views of the Holy Land and the crusader stronghold of Kerak. Overnight at your Petra hotel.

Day 2 Petra

Full day tour of the ancient city of Petra. The hidden Treasury is approached via the 1.4 km narrow rock canyon, or Siq. Overnight at your hotel. B

Day 3 Tour ends Amman

Morning at leisure before returning via the Desert Highway to Amman. Alternatively, enjoy an optional visit to the desert landscapes of Wadi Rum for a 4 hour jeep excursion with Bedouin driver/guide (includes lunch). Tour ends Amman. B

Note: A 4 day tour is available, allowing time for an extra visit to Petra and/or a visit to nearby Al Baidah (Little Petra), the major Nabatean caravanserai with its ancient rock carved streets and temples.

Day 3 King Aretas Camp

Depart after breakfast to Wadi Rum for your 4 hour desert excursion by jeep with a Bedouin driver/guide. Overnight at the exotic King Aretas IV camp inside the National Reserve. The camp caters for 100 guests in comfortable canvas sleeping tents with separate modern shower and toilet block, lounge areas under bedouin tents, excellent restaurant, bar and evening entertainment. Day 4 Tour ends Amman

After breakfast drive back via the Desert Highway to Amman where your tour ends. B
