



ECUADOR

Although famous for the Galapagos Islands, mainland Ecuador also has spectacular scenery, wildlife, history and Andean cultures. Straddling the equator, from which comes its name, this tiny country is easy to explore, from the Pacific Coast to the towering snowcapped volcanoes of the Andes and then down again to pristine Amazon Rainforest. The towns of Quito and Cuenca are treasure troves of architecture, with beautiful churches, convents, museums and wonderful crafts.

ECUADOR ECO-LODGES

Discover the amazing natural wonders of pristine Amazon jungle whilst staying in comfortable eco-lodges that ensure minimum impact on their fragile environment. These lodges offer a broad range of activities, including guided walks through the forest where you will be amazed by the rich and diverse display of flora and fauna including tropical birds, many species of monkey, a variety of reptiles, frogs and sloths to name but a few. Float by canoe across quiet lakes, home to giant otters or caiman (alligators) and climb observation towers into the forest canopy for a breathtaking view of the jungle as birds fly by at eye level.

The climate in the Amazon is always hot and humid with the chance of rain so it is best to be prepared for all conditions. The average temperatures are from about 20°C to 28°C. As a general rule, Ecuador's rainforest is drier from November to February and wettest from June to September.

LA SELVA LODGE



On the shores of Garzacocha Lake, La Selva ("the jungle") offers comfortable guest accommodation in 17 thatched cabanas made from materials designed to blend with their surroundings. Each cabana has a private bathroom with hot water, a hammock and mosquito netting over the beds. The lodge has a spacious dining room and an open-air bar/lounge with lake views. Activities include an observation tower, walks, fishing, boat trips to a butterfly farm and night excursions.
