



RWANDA

Tiny, landlocked Rwanda is incredibly beautiful. While the locals are warm and welcoming, the nation's gorillas remain its biggest drawcard. Parc National des Volcans (Volcanoes National Park) is the best place to view the magnificent mountain gorilla in its natural habitat. For chimpanzee and a host of other primates, head to primeval Nyungwe Forest. Rwanda is close to the Equator but altitude keeps the climate pleasant, with the country's montane rainforests being cool to cold. Rain falls all year but is heaviest Mar-May and Oct-Nov

Airport transfers in Kigali, city tour, accommodation and meals as per itinerary, transportation by 4WD vehicle, English speaking driver, 1 gorilla permit, park fees, mineral water, temporary Flying Doctor service membership. Local drinks (except premium) & laundry included at Bisate, Sabyinyo Lodge & The Bishop's House.

EXCLUSIONS

Optional 2nd gorilla trek permit (4D/3N tour) \$1500 USD per person, Virunga Porter fee for the hike \$20 USD per person per trek & visa fees.

Travel to Rwanda, just one hour's flight from Nairobi and experience one of the most unforgettable wildlife encounters of a lifetime. The last remaining wild mountain gorillas live in the Virunga Volcanoes of northern Rwanda. They were made famous by Dian Fossey who dedicated her life to their conservation and immortalised them in the film 'Gorillas in the Mist'.

To make the most of your trip, we strongly recommend a 3 night stay. For both itinerary options, we recommend you arrive and overnight in Kigali, driving to the Virungas the following day.

BOTH ITINERARIES

Day 1 Kigali

Arrive Kigali and check into your city hotel. D

Day 2 Parc National des Volcans

Enjoy a city tour including the sobering Genocide Museum, followed by lunch. Transfer to your lodge (2hrs) near Parc National des Volcans for overnight. BLD

Day 3 Tour ends or Parc National des Volcans

Have an early breakfast followed by a 0615 departure to park HQ for the start of your gorilla trek. Once found, a maximum of 1 hour can be spent with a troop. Lunch at your lodge before returning to Kigali airport where your tour ends (3D/2N) or relax before dinner (4D/3N) BLD

Day 4 Tour ends Kigali

Optional second gorilla trek, lunch, and then return to Kigali airport where your adventure concludes. BL.

BISATE LODGE

With wonderful views of the Virunga Volcanoes, this luxury lodge is just minutes from park headquarters. Up to 18 guests are accommodated in picturesque stone cottages with verandas, sitting areas, fireplaces and ensuite bathrooms. The main lodge has a dining room, lounge, library and shop.
