

# SELOUS & RUAHA

4 days/3 nights

Departs ex Dar es Salaam

Follow in the footsteps of early African explorers in the unspoilt wilderness of Selous and Ruaha in southern Tanzania. Named after the legendary Frederick Courtney Selous, and covering over 50,000 sq kms, the Selous Game Reserve is Africa's largest protected wilderness. Its unique ecosystem encompasses great rivers and lakes, forests and woodland, providing a diverse range of habitat for wildlife, and was designated a World Heritage Site in 1982. The remote and wild Ruaha National Park covers 10,300 sq kms and is home to many rare species, including striped hyena, lesser kudu, sable and roan antelope. Both parks are accessed by light aircraft from Dar es Salaam or Zanzibar and it is possible to combine two or more lodges. Gameviewing is by 4WD vehicle, by boat and on foot.



## SAND RIVERS SELOUS

4 days/3 nights from \$3925 per person twin share\*

Owned by Nomad Tanzania (see p138), **Sand Rivers Selous** overlooks the Rufiji River and offers 5 open-fronted thatched cottages with ensuite bathroom overlooking the river and 3 hillside suites with plunge pools. There is a central bar, dining room and pool. Activities include walks with a professional guide, boat trips, and game drives by open 4WD. Flycamping is also available (optional extra).

### INCLUSIONS

Light aircraft transfer Dar es Salaam to Selous return, full board accommodation, drinks (except champagne and premium wines), laundry, park fees, airstrip transfers, 2 shared game activities on each full day and an activity on arrival and departure days if time permits. Luggage Limit: 15kgs. Children 8+ (children under 12 cannot participate in walking or fly camping).

## SIWANDU

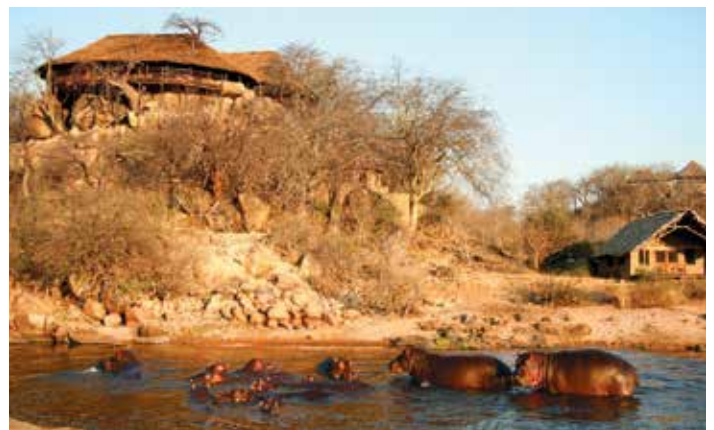
4 days/3 nights from \$3942 per person twin share\*

Located on the shores of Lake Nzerakera is **Siwandu**. Operating as 2 self-sufficient camps, North Camp offers 6 luxury tented suites and South offers 7. All suites are built on raised wooden platforms with ensuite facilities. Each camp has a dining room, bar and pool and operates its own activities including game drives by open 4WD, river cruises and bush walks. Siwandu has a sister camp, **Jongomero** in the Ruaha National Park and an exclusive beach retreat, **Ras Kutani**, on the Indian Ocean coast.

Light aircraft transfer Dar es Salaam to Selous return, full board accommodation, laundry, airstrip transfers, park fees, 2 shared game activities on each full day and an activity on arrival and departure days if time permits. Luggage Limit: 15kgs. Children 6+ (children under 16 cannot participate in walking or fly camping).

## RUAHA RIVER LODGE

4 days/3 nights from \$2795 per person twin share\*

Situated in remote and beautiful Ruaha NP, **Ruaha River Lodge** is run by Peter and Sarah Fox, who have lived in this area all their lives. Guests are accommodated in 24 stone and thatch chalets overlooking the river, each with ensuite bathroom. Meals are prepared with fresh produce from the Foxes' highland farm. Game drives by open 4WD vehicle are conducted with well-trained guides. Other properties run by the Foxes are **Vuma Hills** and **Stanley's Kopje** in Mikumi NP, **Katavi Wildlife Camp** in Katavi NP and **Lazy Lagoon Island Hideaway** by the Indian Ocean.

### INCLUSIONS

Light aircraft transfer Dar es Salaam to Ruaha return, full board accommodation, laundry, airstrip transfers, park fees, 2 shared game activities on each full day and an activity on arrival and departure days if time permits. Luggage Limit: 15kgs. Children of all ages welcome.
