The beautiful “spice island” of Zanzibar is steeped in the history of past civilisations. The Arab and Persian traders who arrived during the 8th century established Islamic belief. By the 17th century, Zanzibar was the main port of call on busy spice, ivory and slave trading routes. Day 1 Zanzibar

Arrive Zanzibar. Transfer to hotel of your choice.

Days 2/3 Zanzibar

Morning city tour including the Zanzibar Market, Zanzibar Museum, the Sultan’s Palace and House of Wonders. Wander the narrow lanes of Stone Town with its old houses, vibrant small bazaars and curio shops. In the afternoon, enjoy a spice tour, seeing and tasting a variety of spices such as clove, cinnamon, black pepper and cardamom. Day 3 is at leisure.

Day 4 Tour ends

Transfer to the airport where the tour ends.

ZANZIBAR PALACE HOTEL

Located in a tall, narrow building in the heart of Stone Town, the award-winning Zanzibar Palace Hotel has 9 individually designed rooms with Arabian, Indian and English touches that pay homage to the multi-cultural heritage of Zanzibar. The hotel also has a wellness spa and restaurant.

KISIWA HOUSE

On a quiet street at the centre of Stone Town, Kisiwa House occupies a fine 19th century building that was once a wealthy merchant’s home. The hotel offers 9 sleek, sophisticated rooms and suites, an evocative rooftop restaurant and an enchanting courtyard lounge.

ZANZIBAR SERENA HOTEL

This refined small hotel sits on the breezy waterfront of historic Stone Town amid former palaces and forts. It features 51 sophisticated ocean-facing guestrooms with private balconies, two restaurants (including an atmospheric rooftop restaurant), poolside dining, and a lively cocktail bar.

DHOW PALACE HOTEL

This restored heritage mansion is a living museum once home to a rich merchant. There are 30 spacious ensuite guestrooms, some with sweeping views of the Indian Ocean. A small courtyard pool and an onsite restaurant offer welcome refreshment throughout the day.

MARU MARU HOTEL

Located in the middle of Stone Town, Maru Maru has a distinctive Afro-Arabian style, typical of Zanzibari architecture. Once famous for its marble floors, it has been lovingly restored and features 51 beautiful guestrooms. Facilities include a large rooftop swimming pool and terrace restaurant.
