Return transfers from airport to Zanzibar Stone Town, city tour and spice tour and 3 nights accommodation on a bed & breakfast basis.

The beautiful “spice island” of Zanzibar is steeped in the history of past civilisations. The Arab and Persian traders who arrived during the 8th century established Islamic belief. By the 17th century Zanzibar was the main port of call on the ancient spice, ivory and slave trading routes. Today it is a mix of many cultures, and visitors are captivated by the unique architecture, the exotic cuisine, the hospitality of the people and the white sand beaches. Day 1 Zanzibar

Arrive Zanzibar. Transfer to hotel of your choice.

Days 2/3 Zanzibar

Morning city tour including the Zanzibar Market, Zanzibar Museum, the Sultan’s Palace and House of Wonders. Wander the narrow lanes of Stone Town with its old houses, vibrant small bazaars and curio shops. In the afternoon enjoy a spice tour, seeing and tasting a variety of spices such as clove, cinnamon, black pepper and cardamom. Day 3 is at leisure.

Transfer to the airport where the tour ends.

ZANZIBAR SERENA HOTEL

A member of the respected ‘Small Luxury Hotels of the World’, the Serena Inn is situated on the sea front in historic Stone Town. It features 51 ocean-facing, air-conditioned rooms each with private balcony and bathroom. Facilities include a beachside restaurant, roof-top terrace, bar and pool.

DHOW PALACE HOTEL

This 19th century restored heritage mansion is a living museum. There are 30 air-conditioned, spacious ensuite rooms, some with sweeping views of the Indian Ocean. A small courtyard pool and an onsite restaurant offer refreshment throughout the day.

MARU MARU HOTEL

The Maru Maru Hotel is located in the centre of Stone Town and has a distinctive Afro-Arabian style, typical of the Zanzibari architecture. The hotel consists of a classic wing housing 11 rooms and a more modern featuring 33 rooms. Facilities include a roof top terrace with 360 degree views.
