- Day 1 Sitka - Embarkation**
Beautiful Sitka is the starting point of your adventure, a place full of historic sites such as St Michael's Cathedral and the Russian Bishop's House.
- Day 2 Wilderness Bay and Kake**
Beachcomb or hike along a secluded coastline. Later, marvel at the world's tallest totem pole and gain an introduction into the Tlingit way of life through a carving demonstration and by strolling the village of Kake.
- Day 3 Petersburg**
Experience the Norwegian flavour of this character-filled fishing town sometimes called "Little Norway" by taking in a folk dance show and an embarking on a narrated bus tour.
- Day 4 Frederick Sound**
Seek out humpbacks and other marine mammals in Frederick Sound. There's time this afternoon for personal exploration by kayak, skiff or on foot.
- Day 5 Tracy Arm**
Be awed by the unsurpassable majesty of Tracy Arm, a steep-sided 51km-long fjord lined with waterfalls and glaciers. Skiff excursions allow for closer inspection of the seal-filled waters.

Day 6 Cruising and Orca Point Lodge
Enjoy an unscripted day of discovery, perhaps paddling quiet inlets or hiking beneath ancient trees. Tonight, dine on Alaskan favourites such as king crab or salmon at cosy Orca Point Lodge.

Day 7 Glacier Bay National Park
This astonishing reserve contains eight tidewater glaciers and a dazzling array of wildlife from mountain goats, Steller sea lions and wolves to brown and black bears. A native Huna Tlingit naturalist and park ranger will help you unlock the national park's secrets today.

Day 8 Juneau - Disembark
A transfer to the airport or your hotel is included on disembarkation in the Alaskan capital city of Juneau.
