This all-encompassing cruise takes in three compelling ports, the former gold rush town of Skagway, the adventure capital of Haines and the Nordic-style community of Petersburg. Explore the dramatic landscapes by kayak, skiff or on foot.

Day 1 Sitka - Embarkation

There's time to explore this historic town which faces the Gulf of Alaska, before embarking by ship into the winding narrows north of town, searching for bald eagles, bears and other wildlife.

Day 2 Cruising

Today is an unscripted day of discovery, with opportunities to paddle up close to whales or hike through old-growth forest.



Day 3 Glacier Bay National Park

Venture into America's finest reserve with a National Park Ranger and native Huna Tlingit naturalist guide. Margerie Glacier is a highlight, known for its spectacular calving displays.

Day 4 Skagway and Haines

Retrace the steps of prospectors in Skagway and ride along an old railroad into Canada (passport required). A guided walk through Haines takes you to an interesting pre-WWI fort.

Day 5 Juneau and Orca Point Lodge

See the famed Mendenhall Glacier and visit the Alaska State Museum. Conclude the day at the exclusive Orca Point Lodge, located on Colt Island, where prime rib, king crab and salmon dinners can be had.

Day 6 Tracy Arm and Frederick Sound

Navigate Tracy Arm, a dramatic fjord lined with waterfalls whose waters brim with seals and icebergs. Skiff excursions allow closer inspection of this majestic area before you enter the whale-rich waters of Frederick Sound.

Day 7 Petersburg

Experience Scandinavian culture in Petersburg, also known as "Little Norway", by taking in a folk dance. There's free time to explore following a narrated bus tour.

Day 8 Wrangell

Unravel the history of a town once ruled by four nations: the Tlingit, Russia, England and the United States. At the Petroglyph Beach State Historic Park, view intriguing petroglyphs.

Day 9 Thorne Bay and Kasaan

Meet resident artists in what was once the largest logging camp in the world, then walk in an enchanting forest laden with intricate totem poles to the only remaining traditional Haida longhouse in the United States.

Day 10 Metlakatla and Misty Fjords

Immerse yourself in art, history and culture as you wander a Tsimshian longhouse, witness a ceremonial dance and interact with native craftsmen. Back on board, glide beneath the great cliffs of Misty Fjords.

Day 11 Ketchikan - Disembark

Alight in the "Salmon Capital of the World" and transfer to your hotel or the airport.
