**B**ute Inlet and the surrounding wilderness around Campbell River is renowned for some of the best Grizzly Bear viewing in the world. Less than an hour's flight from Vancouver, the area also boasts excellent marine life, and is home to orcas, minke whales and dolphins. Explore this unique landscape on foot or by boat, or simply relax and watch the wildlife at countless viewing platforms offering unparalleled viewing opportunities.

### INCLUSIONS

Boat ride and road transfers from Campbell River. Light picnic lunch, water, tea and coffee. Services of onboard Marine Naturalists.

### ITINERARY

Depart from Campbell River and travel the picturesque waterways by boat to Bute Inlet (approximately 2 hours). From here you will then travel by road to numerous viewing platforms where you may spend memorable moments observing grizzly bears foraging and fishing for salmon in the rivers and streams. This area boasts the perfect conditions for the bears to hunt for food as they prepare for their winter hibernation.
