**O**bserve pods of the rare and elusive narwhal beneath the Midnight Sun on this exclusive fly-in safari. At the ice floe edge in the northern reaches of Baffin Island are a wealth of other amazing Arctic species, including polar bears, seals, beluga and bowhead whales.

### Day 1 Navy Board Inlet

Morning flight Ottawa to Pond Inlet via Iqaluit, followed by a private air transfer to camp. Settle in with a hot and hearty welcome dinner. D

### Days 2-5 Base Camp

Travel to the ice floe edge by snowmobile or qamutik (traditional sled). Hike stunning Arctic landscapes, kayak amongst sea ice and snorkel in whale-rich waters. You may also visit Bylot Island, where up to 200,000 seabirds nest annually, and tour evocative ancient Thule sites. BLD

### Day 6 Pond Inlet

Enjoy a final full day of exploration before flying back to Pond Inlet. Overnight in a hotel. BLD

### Day 7 Tour ends Ottawa

Transfer to the airport for your flight to Ottawa. Tour ends. BL
