**T**ake in four designated Wilderness Areas or National Monuments as well as Tlingit culture, glaciers and grizzlies on this amazing circuit from Petersburg, nicknamed “Little Norway”. Explore the region via your expedition ship, by kayaks, skiff and on foot.

#### Day 1 Petersburg

Check in at your hotel, then head into town to admire the vibrant fishing harbour. D

#### Day 2 Petersburg - Embarkation

Flightseeing, fishing or a beach walk - make the most of your free morning in Petersburg. Board the vessel late afternoon and settle in with a glass of champagne, as you sail into Frederick Sound. BD

#### Day 3 Kake/Keku Islands

Listen to Tlingit legends and learn about totems as tribal members share their stories. Skiff or kayak the fingerling Keku Islands, going ashore for a tidal zone walk. BLD

#### Day 4 Tebenkof Bay / South Baranof Wilderness Areas

Go into the wild today - Tebenkof Bay is a mosaic of islands and forests, whilst South Baranof is all steep-sided granite walls and rushing waterfalls. Pull on gumboots to muddle through muskeg and tidal pools, paddleboard to get up close to curious creatures such as sea lions and sea stars or take a “polar bear plunge” if you dare! BLD

#### Day 5 Admiralty Island National Monument

Tlingit call this place “Kootznoowoo” or “Fortress of the Bear” and rightly so - this is where you’ll find the highest concentration of brown bears on Earth. Take a thrilling hike through bear country, then lower your pulse by relaxing on the sundeck. BLD

#### Day 6 Endicott Arm / Dawes Glacier

Skiff up the iceberg-littered waters of Endicott Arm to reach the magnificent Dawes Glacier. Pause to view periscoping seals, and perhaps to touch and taste a chunk of glacial ice. BLD

#### Day 7 Scenery Cove

How you wish to explore this backcountry wilderness today is totally up to you. Kayak, hike or skiff this hidden natural playground. BLD

#### Day 8 Stikine-LeConte Wilderness Area

Discover a river of ice and the northern hemisphere’s southernmost tidewater glacier. Motor past icebergs or hike along the scenic Three Lakes Trail. Celebrate your adventure with a Farewell Dinner and slideshow. BLD

#### Day 9 Petersburg - Disembark

After breakfast, it’s time for goodbyes and a transfer to the airport. B
