INCLUSIONS

Arrival transfer Chihuahua airport to hotel, 5 nights hotel accommodation (Hotel Fiesta Inn Chihuahua, Best Western The Lodge at Creel Hotel & Spa, Hotel Mirador, Posada del Hidalgo), meals, transfers and tours as per itinerary, first class Chepe train ticket, departure transfer hotel to Los Mochis airport.

Travel on the El Chepe train through the spectacular Copper Canyon on one of the great rail journeys of Latin America. Wider and deeper than the Grand Canyon, with copper green walls, this remarkable series of canyons is a maze of gorges, waterfalls and giant rocks located in Chihuahua state, north-east of Mexico. The train covers 673km from Chihuahua to Los Mochis near the coast, traversing 39 bridges and 87 tunnels. Overnight accommodation is in hotels.

Day 1 Chihuahua

Transfer from Chihuahua airport to hotel. Rest of the day at leisure.



Day 2 Creel

Transfer to Chihuahua station and board the first class El Chepe train. Travel through rugged mountains to Creel. Enjoy a half day tour of Arareko Lake, Tarahumara Caves, Mushroom Valley and San Ignacio Mission. Overnight Creel. B

Days 3/4 Posada Barrancas

After breakfast, board the train and continue through dramatic scenery to Posada Barrancas. Explore the town and settle into the spectacularly positioned Hotel Mirador (2 nights), perched on the edge of the canyon with breathtaking views. On Day 4 embark on an excursion to the Divisadero lookout point to enjoy panoramic canyon views, visit the famous balancing rock at Piedra Volada and ride over the canyon on the third largest cable car in the world. BL/BLD

Day 5 El Fuerte

Board the train at Posada Barrancas and descend towards the coast arriving into El Fuerte for overnight at the Hotel Posada del Hidalgo. B

Day 6 Tour ends

After breakfast, transfer by taxi from El Fuerte to Los Mochis. Tour ends. B
