PERU'S INCA TRAILS

Peru's famous trekking routes are possibly the most spectacular in the Americas. They combine breathtaking mountain scenery, lush cloud forests, subtropical jungles, and of course, magnificent Inca ruins. The Machu Picchu Sanctuary is inhabited by over 300 species of orchid and 400 species of bird including hummingbirds and the Andean Condor.

The routes include an impressive variety of altitudes up to 4,560m, diverse ecosystems, and conclude with a visit to Machu Picchu. The treks are rated moderate so you will need to be reasonably fit and in good health to cope with the conditions.

INCA TRAIL INFORMATION


Fair Treatment Porter Policy: To comply with this policy clients are given a special bag for their belongings limited to 7kg.

Permits & Bookings: Only 500 permits are issued each day (porters & guides included). This means permits can often sell out months in advance so early booking is essential.

Altitude: We strongly recommend you spend 2 days at altitude before the trek so your body can adjust.

INCA TRAIL CLASSIC

4 days/3 nights from \$2147 per person twin share
Departs Mondays & Wednesdays ex Cusco (Jan & Mar-Dec)

INCLUSIONS

3 nights accommodation in two-person tents, licensed English speaking guide, camping equipment, oxygen bottle, chef and assistant, portage, transport from Cusco to start of the trail, Inca Trail Permit, one-way Vistadome train ticket Machu Picchu Pueblo to Poroy, transfer Poroy train station to Cusco, sleeping bag.

This is the classic 4 day Inca Trail to Machu Picchu. You will need to be able to hike up to 10 hours a day, but the incredible views are worth the effort. Highlights include wonderful vistas of the Huayanay massif's snowy peaks from Warmiwañusca Pass (4,200m), the forested Pacaymayo Valley, as well as the Sayacmarca and Winay Wayna ruins. On the last morning arrive at Machu Picchu with plenty of time to explore the ruins before returning to Cusco by train. Please note the Inca Trail is closed in February.



LARES TREK TO MACHU PICCHU

5 days/4 nights from \$2820 per person twin share
Departs ex Cusco

INCLUSIONS

Transportation with pick up and drop off in Cusco, accommodation, meals (except breakfast on day 1 and dinner on the last day of the program), soft drinks, daily activities, guided visit of Machu Picchu Sanctuary (including entrance & transportation to the site and Huayna Picchu permit), guides, tips for staff at lodge (excluding guides).

This tailored trek allows you to choose your day-to-day experiences as you make your way from Cusco to the renowned Lost City of the Incas. Perfect for multi-generational groups, visit local communities and learn about their way of life, inspect ancient archaeological sites atop rugged mountains and trek through breathtaking scenery; all whilst enjoying the comforts of a beautiful hotel. Daily hikes are between 1-4 hrs and range from easy to difficult.



SALKANTAY TREK TO MACHU PICCHU

7 days/6 nights from \$4440 per person twin share
Departs ex Cusco

INCLUSIONS

6 nights lodge/hotel accommodation, meals (except breakfast on day 1 and dinner on the last day of the program), some non-alcoholic drinks, bilingual guide, portage, guided visit of Machu Picchu Sanctuary (includes entrance and transportation to the site and permits), trains from Hydroelectric station/Machu Picchu Pueblo & Machu Picchu Pueblo/Ollantaytambo, US\$50 gratuities for services staff (excluding guides).

Trek from lodge to lodge along the ancient Salkantay Inca Trail on your journey to Machu Picchu. Traverse diverse terrain with extraordinary views of towering snow-capped peaks and encounter the sacred Apu (mountain spirits) of local Quechua communities. Hiking varies from easy to challenging. At the end of each day you can relax in Mountain Lodges of Peru's comfortable, high quality accommodations and enjoy exquisite Peruvian cuisine.



EXPLORA VALLE SAGRADO

5 days/4 nights from \$4110 per person twin share
Departs ex Cusco

INCLUSIONS

Transfers between airport and Explora Valle Sagrado, full board accommodation, bar, daily explorations with English speaking guide as per program options and equipment, shared full day Machu Picchu tour including Vistadome train (round trip), a packed lunch and entrance fee to Machu Picchu.

With Explora, you can experience the beauty and history of the Sacred Valley without compromising on comfort. Your base is a stunning lodge on a corn plantation surrounded by mountain peaks. Choose from over 20 explorations – on foot, by van or bicycle. Discover the treasures of Cusco including the temple of Coricancha, upon which a convent was built, or visit Pisac, a remarkable city of hanging agricultural terraces.
