DISCOVER PERU BY RAIL

Travel to Peru's most astounding wonders on board one of PeruRail's excellent trains. No matter which service you choose, each will offer an unforgettable experience. The romantic **Belmond Hiram Bingham** offers one of the world's best rail journeys, travelling between ancient Cusco and the Lost City of the Incas. The ultra-luxurious **Belmond Andean Explorer** sleeper train carries passengers in utmost splendour from the former Inca capital to the white city of Arequipa or to scenic Puno, on Lake Titicaca's shores. The premium **Vistadome** and comfortable **Expedition** are also very popular options with travellers to Machu Picchu, whilst PeruRail's **Titicaca** day service offers awesome scenic beauty and the highest levels of service between Cusco and Puno.



BELMOND HIRAM BINGHAM

This exclusive luxury Belmond service between Cusco and Machu Picchu is named after the explorer who rediscovered the iconic Inca citadel. With its distinctive blue and gold livery, the Hiram Bingham carries up to 84 passengers. The carriages have warm and welcoming interiors in the style of elegant 1920s Pullman cars including two dining cars and an observation wagon with a bar.



BELMOND ANDEAN EXPLORER

South America's first luxury sleeper train offers an overnight service between Cusco and Puno and a two night journey between Cusco and the UNESCO World Heritage city of Arequipa. Guest cabins are private sanctuaries, whose décor is inspired by the tones and textures of local fabrics and Alpaca wool. Sumptuous cuisine is served in the plush dining cars, whilst pisco sours can be enjoyed out on the open decks of the observation car.



THE VISTADOME

This first class train is one of the most popular ways to reach or return from Machu Picchu. Passengers are invited to sit back in very comfortable, semi-reclining seats and enjoy unsurpassed views through the Vistadome's panoramic windows. Regular daily departures are available from three stations to Machu Picchu: Cusco (Poroy), Urubamba and Ollantaytambo. Snacks, drinks and souvenirs can be purchased on board.



THE EXPEDITION

The Expedition is designed for value and comfort, with 48 semi-reclining passenger seats per car. The train also features large panoramic windows, air conditioning and heating, as well as snacks and beverages available for purchase on board. This service offers great convenience and flexibility as it departs every day of the week to Machu Picchu from three stations: Cusco (Poroy), Urubamba and Ollantaytambo.



PERURAIL TITICACA

Passengers on this wonderful train enjoy plenty of leg room with their seats as well as on board traditional live music and dance performances. They also have access to an open-air observatory carriage where they can take in stunning Andean landscapes traversed on the 10.5 hour one-way journey between Cusco and Puno. Multi-course gourmet meals are served during the trip in two classic Pullman dining cars.
