Experience the wonders of Peru's Amazon Rainforest where monkeys call from high in the canopy and brightly coloured butterflies and tropical flowers light up the shady forest floor. Boasting extraordinary biodiversity, remote destinations such as the Manu Rainforest and the Tambopata wilderness allow you to closely observe hundreds of parrots and macaws at a clay lick, huge tapirs foraging on the riverbank and giant river otters frolicking in oxbow lakes. We have suggested 3 and 4 night itineraries here that can be shortened or extended. However, we highly recommend staying 5 days/4 nights for the best Amazon experience.

SANDOVAL LAKE LODGE

5 days/4 nights from \$1269 per person twin share*

4 days/3 nights from \$1003 per person twin share*

Situated in the Tambopata National Reserve, Sandoval Lake Lodge is reached by a leisurely motorised canoe ride and a hike along a beautiful nature trail. Built using natural materials, the lodge overlooks the picturesque palm-rimmed, wildlife-rich Sandoval Lake and offers 25 ensuite rooms with daytime electricity and fans. Naturalist guides accompany small groups on forest treks, lake excursions and night walks.



MANU WILDLIFE CENTER

5 days/4 nights from \$3027 per person twin share*

4 days/3 nights from \$2545 per person twin share*

Reached via a combination of road (4hrs) and shaded motor boat (3hrs) transfers, this famous lodge features 12 thatched ensuite bungalows, a central dining area, lounge and bar. The surrounding rainforest is inhabited by some 1,000 species of bird and 11 species of monkey. Naturalist guides lead excursions to soaring canopy towers, the world's largest known tapir clay lick, a renowned macaw lick and oxbow lakes frequented by rare giant river otters. Operates Mar-Dec only. Pre-night in Puerto Maldonado is required for 0600 transfer to lodge.



REFUGIO AMAZONAS

5 days/4 nights from \$1754 per person twin share*

4 days/3 nights from \$1346 per person twin share*

This authentic jungle lodge sits on a large private concession beside the superb Tambopata National Reserve. Decorated by local artists, the 32 guest rooms feature mosquito netting, private hot water showers and airy verandas. Activities include guided visits to famous macaw clay licks and catamaran cruises on an oxbow lake. Guests can also climb a 30m canopy tower, help discover a new species or enjoy a massage at the wellness centre. Children welcome.



INKATERRA HACIENDA CONCEPCION

5 days/4 nights from \$1120 per person twin share*

4 days/3 nights from \$823 per person twin share*

Accessible only by canoe, Inkaterra Hacienda Concepcion offers adventure lovers an exciting rainforest experience. Situated by the edge of a lake on a 380 hectare private ecological reserve, the resort consists of a main lodge with dining area, bar, lounge and 25 individual cabanas. All feature traditional hand-woven thatched roofs and locally-crafted furnishings. Your tariff includes a choice of quarter and half-day excursions including night walks and river outings.



INKATERRA RESERVA AMAZONICA

5 days/4 nights from \$1154 per person twin share*

4 days/3 nights from \$1056 per person twin share*

Remote and pristine, yet easily accessible by riverboat, Inkaterra Reserva Amazonica is located adjacent to the lush Tambopata National Reserve, known as the "Biodiversity Capital of Peru". The 35 elegant, private thatched roof cabañas feature ceiling fans, warm water showers and low-impact electricity. Lodge facilities include the Inkaterra Canopy Walkway/ Inkaterra Canopy Tree House, day spa, raised walking platforms and an impressive dining pavillion. Expert guides lead a range of excursions including boating, canoeing as well as day and night walks.
