

All are air-conditioned and fitted with a window and porthole. Shared spaces include a dining room, well-stocked bar, welcoming lounge area, library and partially shaded sundeck furnished with loungers.

All ships carry Zodiac boats, snorkelling equipment, full wetsuits and kayaks.
