## M/C TREASURE OF GALAPAGOS

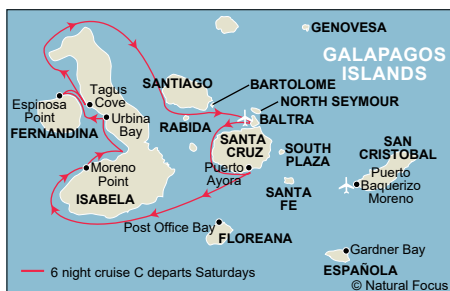
This 124-foot wide catamaran has 9 large ensuite cabins with balconies. Cabins are spread across the quieter Upper and Main Decks, guaranteeing a very comfortable cruise experience. ## M/C ARCHIPPELL I

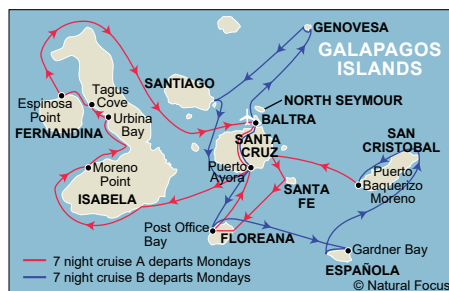
A very comfortable catamaran in the Galapagos, the Archipell I accommodates 16 passengers in 8 air-conditioned double cabins with private bathrooms and hot water. Zodiacs, sea kayaks and snorkelling equipment are carried on board for island activities.

## M/Y GALAPAGOS ODYSSEY

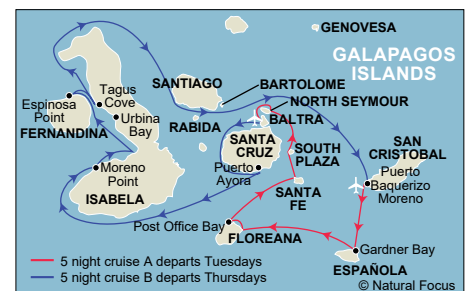
